**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNNISON, COLORADO,  
ENCOURAGING THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF GUNNISON, COLORADO TO  
PARTICIPATE IN THE 2000 NATIONAL CENSUS.**

**WHEREAS,** the United States government will be undertaking a national census in the year 2000; and

**WHEREAS,** the Census is vital to our community in that it determines the apportionment of seats in the United States House of Representatives and the Colorado State Legislature, and is the basis for the allocation of billions of dollars of Federal, State, and County funds for transportation, social, and other programs; and

**WHEREAS,** the Census is also used to help determine where to locate schools, day care centers, senior citizens centers, hospitals, and other facilities and is used to make decisions concerning business growth and jobs; and

**WHEREAS,** Census information is confidential and Federal law prohibits any public or private agency from gaining access to confidential Census data; and

**WHEREAS,** in Gunnison we are committed to a full and accurate Census count and are placing special emphasis on enumerating members of population groups traditionally undercounted; and

**WHEREAS,** in Gunnison we are committed to partnering together with the U.S. Census Bureau in preparing for Census 2000, through address list updates, census map corrections and jurisdictional boundary updates.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNNISON, COLORADO,** that:

- Section 1. Census 2000, is a top priority for all City departments, and appointed and elected officials; and
- Section 2. The City Council encourages the community to place an emphasis within our jurisdiction of partnering together with the U.S. Census Bureau in achieving an accurate and complete count in Census 2000.
