

**RESOLUTION NO. 7

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNNISON, COLORADO, SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF THE GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO TRUST FUND FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE WEST TOMICHI PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Gunnison in conjunction with the Bureau of Reclamation and the Gunnison Land Preservation Board purchased 6.7 acres on the Gunnison River; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gunnison hired DHM Design to work with the City to produce a Master Plan for the parcel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gunnison held two public meetings to solicit input from its' citizenry to guide the development of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gunnison, Colorado accepted the recommendation compiled from the citizen input sessions to support alternative A as the preferred alternative for the development of the West Tomichi Park,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNNISON, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City of Gunnison has accepted the recommendations presented in the West Tomichi Park Master Plan.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Gunnison wishes to support a grant application to the State Board of the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund to aid in funding the development of the West Tomichi Park according to the Master Plan.
