**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNNISON,
COLORADO, IN SUPPORT OF BALLOT ISSUE 1A.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gunnison recognizes the health benefits to the citizens of Gunnison will be enhanced with increased recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the public interest requires it to take formal action in supporting Ballot Issue 1A; and

WHEREAS, an enclosed ice skating and hockey facility with refrigerated ice will provide greater winter athletic opportunity for the residents of Gunnison and comfort for their observers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes each of these projects will have a positive impact on the economic health of Gunnison and elevate the health of the entire community.
