

**NOTICE OF ELECTION
CITY OF GUNNISON
REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION
MAY 9, 2017**

There will be three (3) City Council terms open. Any person who is qualified for the office to be filled may be nominated by petition. A petition shall be signed by not fewer than twenty-five (25) qualified electors for each candidate to be elected. A registered elector may sign petitions for as many persons as there are offices to be filled by the election. Therefore, a registered elector can sign up to three petitions in this election. The two persons receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of office of four years. The third highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of office of two years. All Council seats are non-partisan and represent the entire City. There is one precinct/district. The on-site polling place is at City Hall, 201 W. Virginia Avenue in Gunnison, CO. There will also be four (4) City Charter Amendment questions on the ballot.

To be eligible to be nominated for the City Council vacancies, a person shall be a citizen of the United States, be twenty-one (21) years of age or older, and have been a resident of the City of Gunnison for at least one (1) year immediately preceding the last day for filing the original petition (February 27, 2016) for such office.

If you have been a resident of the City for at least 22 days prior to the election, as of April 19, 2017, or if you are a current City registered voter at the office of the Gunnison County Clerk, you are eligible to vote in the City election, you are eighteen (18) years of age or older, and a citizen of the United States. Voter registration is done at the County Clerk's Election Office in the County's Blackstock Government Building, 221 N. Wisconsin Street, in Gunnison, across from the Post Office or on-line at www.sos.state.co.us/voter-classic/secuRegVoterIntro.do

The Election will be conducted as a Mail Ballot Election. Mail Ballots may be mailed to all active registered City electors starting on Monday, April 17, 2017. If you are a registered voter but will not be at your residence between April 17, 2017, and May 9, 2017, and would like your ballot mailed to another location, please request an absentee ballot form at the City Clerk's office, 201 W. Virginia Avenue in Gunnison or by calling 970-641-8140.
