**CITY OF GUNNISON COUNCIL
SPECIAL SESSION MEETING MINUTES**

7:00 P.M.

The City Council Special Session meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M., by Mayor Pro Tem Ferguson with Councilors Riggs, Steinbeck, and Hagan present along with City Manager Coleman, City Clerk Davidson, Finance Director Hanson, and the press. Mayor Drexel was absent. A Council quorum was present.

Cancellation and Revocation of City Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License Held by Dennis and Mary Lass, dba Blue Iguana Cantina, 303 E. Tomichi Ave.

Councilor Hagan moved and Councilor Steinbeck seconded the motion to approve the revocation and cancellation of the City's Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License held by Dennis and Mary Lass, doing business as Blue Iguana Tavern, at 303 East Tomichi Avenue. Councilor Riggs asked the City Clerk if the revocation is standard procedure. Clerk Davidson stated that even though the licensees failed to renew the license with both the State and the City, State Liquor Enforcement is requesting the Local Licensing Authority take formal action on revocation of the license.

Roll call vote, yes: Riggs, Ferguson, Steinbeck, Hagan. So carried.


