RESERVATIONS:

If you have special requests, let us know what they are and we will do our best to accommodate you. We generally try to give exhibitors their same location each show. Please let us know what type of merchandise you will be selling.

EXHIBIT SPACE:

Our shows are table top shows, tables will be arranged in islands throughout our event center, exhibitors on the inside of the island customers on the outside. Tables will not be skirted or draped please bring your own table coverings. We will also offer wall tables around the perimeter of the show at a premium. The wall tables will have reasonable space behind the tables for exhibitors and their gear.

Payment:

Vendor Contract must be received at least one week prior to event to ensure space. Payment must be made in full before set-up. Spaces not paid before 3:00pm first day of event will be forfeited. We accept cash, check and all major credit cards for payment. If you do not receive a confirmation at least one week before the show, please contact us.

CANCELLATION:

Any cancellations must be made prior to end of business Wednesday July 20th 2016.

ELECTRICITY:

Please let us know in advance if you need electricity.

SET UP HOURS:

Exhibitor set up hours are Friday July 22nd from 7:00am till 3:30pm, Saturday July 23rd from 7:00am till 8:45am, and Sunday July 24th from 7:00am till 8:45am

EVENT HOURS:

**Friday 4:00pm to 8:00pm
Saturday 9:00am to 5:00pm
Sunday 9:00am—2:00pm**

SECURITY:

We provide overnight security Friday night from closing time until we open the doors in the morning. Security is the exhibitor's responsibility during setup, show hours and tear down. Small, valuable items should be displayed in glass cases for security. All guns should be secured with a cable security system through the trigger guards. We will have a licensed FFL dealer present providing background checks for all gun sales.

EXHIBITOR ASSIGNMENTS AND PASSES:

Confirmation card will be sent out when payment is received. Table assignments and wristbands will be given at check in, two exhibitor wristbands for each table and one for each additional table. Please ask for any additional needs.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

1. Pornographic materials, drug paraphernalia, items glorifying Nazism, items offensive to the general public.
2. Loaded firearms
3. Loose rounds of ammunition
4. Concealed guns without permit

REGULATED ITEMS:

1. All pepper spray must be secured
2. Smokeless powder: check with local law enforcement before each show
3. The following items must be approved for sale by the show manager and the concessionaire: food and candy
4. Laser scopes may only be operated by vendors and only pointed at the ceiling.

Disclaimer: The responses to these questions are not intended as any form of legal advice. The responses are generalized answers to some of the most frequently asked questions we receive. You should check with the federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives if you have further questions on any issue relating to the buying or selling of firearms.

Q: Can I bring a gun to the show to sell or trade?

A: Yes, and many folks do. Please be sure the gun is unloaded before you enter the building, and take it to our gun check table at the show entry for verification. They will clear it and secure it with a nylon tie to disable the action. **No loaded firearms and no loaded magazines are permitted in any Gunnison Gun Show and Expo.** Your personal safety is our number one priority while you are at the show. Background checks are required on all gun sales at the Gunnison Gun Show.

Q: Can I qualify for my Concealed Carry Permit at the show?

A: Qualifications for C.C.P.s vary by state. You may take the test and complete all necessary paperwork for a Colorado Concealed Carry Permit at a Gunnison Gun Show. Additionally, classes qualifying you for a Concealed Carry Permit are sometimes held around the Gunnison County.

Q: Can I carry a loaded gun in the gun show? I have a Concealed Carry Permit.

A: Absolutely not no loaded firearms will be allowed into the gun show. Safety is our Number One Priority, and a safe environment in the show can only be maintained if there are no loaded guns in the show.

Q: Can I buy a gun at a gun show if I am a resident of another state?

A: In general, you must provide proof of residency in the state where you are purchasing a gun, whether at a gun store or at a gun show. However, you may place an order with a licensed dealer at a gun show and arrange to have the firearm shipped to a dealer in your state of residence, which can be delivered to you in your state of residence after completing the required Federal forms and meeting state requirements (if there are any requirements in addition to the Federal law.)

Q: How much does it cost to get in the gun show?

A: The admission costs is \$4 each day or a three day pass for \$7. Children 10 and under are admitted free with a supervising adult, and we encourage family participation at Gunnison Gun Show and Expo.

Q: What time does the gun show open to the public?

A: Public Hours for the shows are from 4:00pm till 8:00pm on Friday, 9:00am till 5:00pm, and 9:00am till 2:00pm on Sunday

Q: Where do we get tickets to Gunnison Gun Show?

A: They are available at the entrance to the show.

Q: Can I get a gun appraised at the gun show?

A: Yes, there are many collectors and collector-dealers at the Gunnison Gun Show. Since no one is designated as the official appraiser for the show, you are encouraged to talk to several dealers and collectors to determine the value of any firearm if you are planning to sell it.

Q: I have a collection of guns that I have built up over the past twenty years or so, and I would like to sell some of them now. Can I get a table to sell them if I don't have a license?

A: Yes, you may buy, sell or trade at any gun show if you are a private collector and set up at a show on an occasional basis. You must have a Federal Firearms License if you are "engaged in the business" of dealing in firearms on a regular basis. You should check with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms for clarification if you sell more than occasionally at any gun show. Background checks are required on all gun sales at the Gunnison Gun Show.

Q: Do I need a city sales tax license to sell firearms at the Gunnison Gun Show?

A: Yes, if you are selling firearms at the Gunnison Gun Show you will need to purchase a city sales tax license as per, (the home charter rule) here in Gunnison. The sales tax license is simple to fill out and only costs \$5.50, it is good from July—December each year.
