

Calls for service are leveling out with the advent of cooler weather, however officers are staying busy. The individuals were involved in a fraud scheme resulting in loses of over \$7000 to a local resident. The subjects are being held pending a governors warrant authorizing their return.

The victim was taken to the hospital by ambulance. The suspect in this case has been identified and a warrant has been issued for his arrest.
