

September saw some reclassification of duties for the Community Resource Officer position. We have talked about getting into the schools more over the last few years and the CRO position was originally designed for that purpose. So starting this year the CRO is assigned to the schools or school related activities 8 to 4, Monday thru Friday. After school or on school breaks they will coordinate community outreach or perform directed patrol focused on pedestrian, bikes and traffic issues. If need the officer assigned is still available to respond and help as needed. The position also remains a patrol assignment so they can work extra shifts and cover special events.

Officers responded to a disturbance call on September 7th involving two roommates and a visiting friend. The roommates had been arguing and the friend became involved. During the argument one of the parties pointed a loaded handgun at the other two and attempted to fire the handgun which malfunctioned.

As this report is a few days late a couple events the first of October should be brought to council's attention. On October 2nd I reported to Council that several vehicle windows were broken out by what appeared to be a BB gun during the night of October 1st. On the evening of October 4th two suspects were identified as being involved in an incident in the Love's parking lot where two individuals were shot with a BB gun. One of the individuals required medical treatment as a BB entered the individuals' neck close to an artery. The two suspects in this last incident have been identified and warrants have been issued. This incident is also connected to the damaged windows and additional charges are pending.
