

POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

November 6, 2012

As was reported last month warrants were issued in connection with the broken windows on October 2nd and the assault on October 4th, where a BB gun was used. The two subjects identified in those cases were arrested in Arizona and are being extradited back to Colorado.

The police department also finished the investigation on a sexual assault that occurred in May of last year. The investigation had been waiting on lab results. Warrants were issued for two individuals, one of which was arrested in the Denver area and already returned to Gunnison. The other was arrested in Indiana and extradition is being arranged.

Halloween saw a lot of people out. The downtown closure occurred with mixed opinions depending on who you talked to. But I think overall the closure was appreciated. Several people made comments that it seemed calmer with the streets closed. From my observations and asking other officers the numbers downtown as well as in the neighborhoods later in the night seemed down from years past. It's hard to get an accurate count though with everyone moving around. Officers did respond to one large party that was broken up and resulted in some tickets for alcohol violations. Officers also investigated an assault where the victim required medical treatment at the hospital. The suspects in that assault have been identified and the investigation is continuing.
