

As council is aware the DOLA Grant received preliminary approval and with Council’s action we are awaiting contracts awarding the City \$650,000 for the construction of a new police department and communications center. With the announcement planning has ramped up and weekly meetings have been scheduled to move the project along.

Police department worked with GCSAPP, Crested Butte Marshall’s Office and City Market on April 27 and 29<sup>th</sup> and conducted three prescription drug turn in points. A total of 88.5 pounds of prescription medications was collected from the following locations:

- 4/27/13 at City Market – four boxes with 61 pounds
- 4/27/13 at the Crested Butte Marshall’s Office – One bag with 9.5 pounds
- 4/29/13 at the Gunnison Police Department – One box with 18 pounds

Police activity continues to remain consistent for this time of year. Officers did respond to a report of someone looking into vehicles on April 30<sup>th</sup> in the Palisade Addition. They contacted one subject who was arrested for theft. The case remains under investigation and additional vehicles may be identified that were entered. Officers were also advised of a robbery on April 9<sup>th</sup> where a male subject reported being struck by a male subject with a club. After being struck the person took his money and fled. This case is open.

Prior to attending the academy Chris was the general manager for The Gunny Lube and Eric was working for City Market.

The police department and communications is looking at option for increasing our use of NIXLE to accomplish emergency notifications. NIXLE is a subscriber based notification system and we have used it limitedly for a few years. With some incidents in Gunnison

the need for a general notification system is becoming more of a demand. NIXLE has changed its service in recent month and provides more services that we are considering. The NIXLE service will not replace notifications tied to land line phones associated with the 911 system but allow use to reach subscriber cell phone, e-mail and web based accounts.

Chuck and Laurie participated in a meeting on emergency communications training standards. There is a national and state move to require training for communications employees and they are participating in those discussions.
