The police department brought our normal compliment of equipment to City Fest. Getting to put on the tactical equipment is probably the biggest draw with the kids and some of the older kids.

We are finally making progress on getting the satellite system updated in the mobile communications vehicle. This has been a several year process. The grant money was originally being handled by Montrose County who was having difficulty releasing the money. Gunnison County took over the remaining grant money from the State of Colorado in 2014 and has now authorized the purchase. The down payment was made on 8/7 so we will be taking the vehicle to Monument when the parts arrive for installation. The satellite system provides internet access. The mobile communications vehicle was originally purchased with home land security grant money for use by all emergency service providers in the county. Maintenance and upkeep of the vehicle is handled within the communications budget as all the users are assed communications fees.

The Gunnison City App made its public debut at City Fest. As of August 15 the app has been downloaded 92 times. We are continuing to advertise the app at the department level and adding information on it to our other media releases. The ability to pay City bills with the app was added last week.

Landscaping work at the new building is finished. The electric crews finish installing the flag pole this week and the sign should be delivered by the end of August. The parks

crew has done a great job getting the flower beds in and some of the plants are already blooming. The rock borders have been finished so the last major project for this year will be the fence which is scheduled for October.

Chris Isham attended an instructor class for DUI/SFST. This will allow us to recertify officers as needed locally without bring in instructors or sending our officers out of town.

Communications saw some personnel changes in the last month. Jordan Brink was hired and started the training program on July 22nd. Emma McDowell is the newest dispatcher starting her training on August 2nd. Emma takes Marvella Phelps-Maldarella's position. Marvella resigned July 27th to pursue other interests in Gunnison.
