

As was discussed in the semi-annual report, based on criminal reports, activity in town is consistent. You will notice an increase in bike enforcement as the officers have been asked to document their contacts in writing and step up enforcement due to citizen complaints. You will also notice that parking enforcement is back in full swing with written warnings issued the first part of July switching back to tickets once the warning period ended.

The main cell phone carriers were notified in July that we want to start receiving text to 9-1-1. This added feature was discussed by both the communications board and the Gunnison/Hinsdale 9-1-1 Authority Boards with both being in favor. This is just the first step in an estimated 6 month process to actually receive text 9-1-1 messages.

For several years there has been a move to adopted training standards for Colorado Emergency Telecommunications. Laurie is participating in the CO Training Standards Committee so we have some input into the process. There are several training programs recognized around the country but having standards specific to Colorado would help with uniformity and quality between 9-1-1 centers.

With July behind us we can start moving toward fall activities and the return to school and university activities. We have already scheduled a meeting between the police department and university dorm staff. Rob is set for freshman orientation meeting and will have a table at the welcome back events for WSCU. Information on the Good Neighbor Program and meetings with athletic groups on campus will be coming as the students return to class 8/24. Public school starts up a week later, 8/31, so added patrol and safety messages will be in order for 11th Street and surrounding neighborhoods.
