

Both trespasses at residences and theft from vehicles increased in April. In two incidents involving trespasses at residence owners reported finding a Spanish male approximately 20 years old either in their yard or on their porches. The person left when contact and was carrying a backpack. Residents in the Crested Butte area have posted information on Facebook describing a similar person and behavior. No identification has been made and the description is pretty general. The public is being reminded to lock their vehicles and homes.

Officers made arrests in two cases in April where heroin was involved. In one of the cases the officer and ambulance crew revived an individual who was overdosing.

Officer testing has been scheduled for May 16<sup>th</sup>. We have six applicants with a few certified already or graduating from academy in May.

Rob, Keith and Sheriff Besecker met with a group from the immigrant community, April 28<sup>th</sup>, to discuss some of their concerns and issues in the community. The meeting was organized as a result of information received during the One Valley Prosperity Project. Most of the discussion centered on the difficulty with obtaining drivers licenses. The discussions were positive and everyone was agreeable to more meetings in the future.

Rob continued to work with kids in the grade school during April; 2<sup>nd</sup> grade completed Second Step and started five DARE lessons on safety and healthy choices. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade is working on five DARE lessons on safety and making healthy choices. 5<sup>th</sup> grade – finished DARE and planning for DARE graduation in May.

April saw the start of a Moral Recognition Therapy (MRT) class under Rob's direction. It's been a while since we have ran an MRT class which works with high risk youth referred by probation. Both Rob and Grace are instructors for the program. Participants work through a workbook and structure program on how to deal with issues and make choices in a positive manner.
