

What is a SART?

A Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) is a multidisciplinary interagency collaboration that unites its members in a coordinated victim-centered and offender-focused approach to providing specialized sexual assault intervention services to the community. A SART is made up of first responders and service providers.

When does SART meet? What is SART doing?

Gunnison SART convenes with all members on the third Tuesday of each month. We are in the process of developing SART specific protocol and a Medical Forensic Exam Team.

GUNNISON SART PURPOSE STATEMENT

The Sexual Assault Response Team's (SARTs) purpose is to provide a respectful, consistent, and competent approach in working with victims of sexual assault in Gunnison County by providing a multi-disciplinary team effort to a victim-centered, offender-focused response.

Victim-centered?

We give time and consideration to YOUR needs, wishes, and concerns throughout the entire response. We proceed how YOU wish for us to proceed!

Offender-Focused?

We focus the attention of the investigation on the actions and behaviors of the suspect!
